

It's time to build your new home!

You won't need nails or a saw, but you do need:



Wood glue: A wood or craft glue works perfectly to hold your pieces in place. Fast drying is best.



Craft knife or scalpel: Some pieces may need a gentle trim or push to release from the sheet. Be careful!



Paint: We recommend acrylics for easy coverage and quick drying, but you could even use real house paint if you were really getting into character.



Brushes, pencils, markers etc: This is your little house to make your own, so take your pick of decorating materials! (Glitter anyone??)



Here are some possible colour schemes to get your mind thinking about how you might decide to decorate your house. We recommend painting each section of the model before putting the walls together on the base.







1 Front Wall Assembly




2 Balcony Assembly




3 Right Side Wall Assembly




4 Left Side Wall Assembly



5 Back Wall Assembly




6 Balcony and Front Wall Installation



Angle the front wall forward slightly when installing to avoid the front balcony step, then push until the wall is upright to neatly lock the assembly in place.


Looking good, don't stop now!

7 Walls and Front Balcony Installation




At this point, you can install paper behind each window if you like!




Place the chair on the verandah out the front


